Where would I work? This position will primarily serve the children of the Oglala Sioux Tribe at schools and Head Starts on the Pine Ridge Native American Reservation. You may also be asked to occasionally travel with one of our mobile dental trucks to sites throughout Western South Dakota.

What does my schedule look like? We bring care to kids. Each week you will travel to a clinic site with portable dental equipment. You see kids during the day and (if necessary) stay at a nearby hotel at night. You may also have the opportunity for working a modified schedule during the summer months.

Does the travel get old? We prefer to look at it as mission-driven tourism. You'll visit communities throughout the Pine Ridge reservation, Black Hills, and Western South Dakota. In the evenings, we sometimes hike, check out unique museums, search for the best pie, and may even check out a local golf course in the summer. Depending on where you live, some of the clinic sites can be a quick trip without an overnight stay. The best part is, the travel is on us. We make and pay for the hotel reservations and reimburse for mileage and meals.
